**ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE CONWAY:**

- [1] All defined terms used in this Endorsement shall, unless otherwise defined, have the meanings ascribed to them in the Factum of the Monitor dated February 6, 2026.
- [2] The Monitor brings this motion seeking a Claims Procedure Order and an Ancillary Order. The motion is unopposed.
- [3] The Transaction closed on January 30, 2026. The Claims Procedure must be completed in order for distributions to be made to the creditors of ResidualCo. It is appropriate to grant this order so that the Monitor can determine what claims exist for purposes of these distributions. The order is consistent with others granted by this court. It is approved.
- [4] The Ancillary Order extends the stay to May 29, 2026. I am satisfied that the Monitor has acted in good faith and with due diligence. There is sufficient cash on hand to fund these proceedings through the extension and it will enable the Monitor to complete the Claims Process and then return to court for a distribution order. The extension is granted.
- [5] The Monitor's Fourth Report and activities described therein are approved, as are the fees and disbursements of the Monitor and its counsel.
- [6] Orders to go as signed by me and attached to this Endorsement. These orders are effective from today's date and are enforceable without the need for entry and filing.
