SUPPLEMENT TO THE FOURTH REPORT OF KSV RESTRUCTURING INC., IN ITS CAPACITY AS MONITOR

JANUARY 19, 2024

1.0 Introduction

- 1. This report ("Supplemental Report") supplements the Monitor's Fourth Report to Court dated September 26, 2023 ("Fourth Report").
- 2. Unless otherwise stated, capitalized terms used in this report have the meanings provided to them in the Fourth Report.
- 3. Pursuant to orders issued on September 28, 2023, the Court issued:
 - a. the Approval and Vesting Order, among other things:
 - i. approving the Transaction as contemplated by the APA; and
 - ii. vesting all of the Applicant's right, title and interest in and to the Purchased Assets (as defined in the APA) in the Purchaser, free and clear of all encumbrances, other than permitted encumbrances;
 - b. a CCAA Termination Order, among other things:
 - i. discharging KSV in its capacity as the Monitor of the Applicant effective upon the service of a Termination Certificate at the CCAA Termination Time;
 - ii. authorizing the Applicant to make an assignment in bankruptcy pursuant to the BIA prior to the service of the Termination Certificate and authorizing the Monitor, if it so consents, to act as licensed insolvency trustee (the "Trustee");

- iii. releasing and discharging the Administration Charge effective as of the CCAA Termination Time;
- iv. granting certain Releases in favour of the Released Parties;
- v. discharging the CRO effective as at the earlier of (a) the end of the "Initial Term" contemplated in the CRO's engagement letter, being February 12, 2024, or (b) the CCAA Termination Time;
- vi. approving the fees and disbursements of the Monitor and Cassels as described in this Report, including a fee accrual of \$150,000, excluding harmonized sales tax and disbursements, for services until the end of this CCAA proceeding; and
- vii. approving the activities, conduct and reports of the Monitor to date.
- c. an order, extending the Stay Period to the earlier of (i) service of the Termination Certificate, or (ii) January 31, 2024.
- 4. A copy of the CCAA Termination Order is attached as Appendix "A". Paragraph Eight of the CCAA Termination Order states:
 - "THIS COURT ORDERS that concurrent with the delivery by the Monitor of notice of the intended filing of the Monitor's Certificate [Termination Certificate] as provided for in paragraph 7 of this Order, the Monitor shall also prepare and serve on the Service List a Report that provides an update about these proceedings since the time of the Fourth Report including the fees and activities of the Monitor and Cassels and the activities of the remaining Released Parties, in each case, from and after the date of this Order to and including the date of such Report. The Report shall also include fee affidavits sworn by representatives of each of the Monitor and Cassels regarding their respective fees incurred since (i) August 31, 2023 for the Monitor and (ii) September 24, 2023 for Cassels."
- 5. Concurrent with the issuance of this Report, the Monitor is advising the Service List that it intends to serve the Termination Certificate in ten days on January 29, 2024 (in advance of the expiry of the Stay Period on January 31, 2024). If any party objects to any of the relief set to become effective on the filing of the Termination Certificate, notice of such objection must be provided to the Monitor and Cassels in writing, including the grounds therefor, prior to the ten-day period. If such an objection is received, the Monitor may only file the Termination Certificate: (i) if the objection is resolved, or (ii) on further order of this Court.
- 6. As such, the purpose of this Supplemental Report is for the Monitor to comply with paragraph Eight of the CCAA Termination Order and provide an update about these proceedings since the time of the Fourth Report.

7. Since the Fourth Report, the Monitor and Chalice have worked with the Purchaser to close the Transaction. On December 29, 2023, the Transaction closed. As described in the Fourth Report, in connection with the Oregon Court's approval of the Transaction, Chalice was required to pay on closing from the sale proceeds (i) certain settlement payments to parties who asserted secured claims and (ii) certain amounts to the Oregon Receiver for the payment of administrative tax liabilities and certain Oregon state taxes and administrative claims allowed in the Oregon Receivership. After payment of those amounts and certain nominal transaction fees, the net proceeds available to Chalice was US\$61,879.66. In light of the quantum of the net sale proceeds, the Interim Funding (as described in the Second Report of the Monitor dated July 25, 2023) will not be repaid by the Oregon Receivership Entities. After payment of certain fees and employee expenses, Chalice is anticipated to have approximately \$27,000 in its bank account upon termination of these proceedings. Accordingly, there are not sufficient funds available to administer a distribution to creditors of Chalice or to fund a bankruptcy and the Monitor does not intend to consent to being the Trustee of Chalice.

2.0 Professional Fees

- 1. The fees (excluding disbursements and HST) (i) of the Monitor from August 31, 2023 to and including the date of this Supplemental Report total \$37,596.25, and (ii) of Cassels from September 25, 2023 to and including January 18, 2024 total \$16,114.50.
- 2. The average hourly rates for the Monitor and Cassels for the referenced billing periods were \$573.11 and \$875.79, respectively.
- 3. Invoices in respect of the fees and disbursements of the Monitor and Cassels are provided in the exhibits to the fee affidavits attached as Appendices "A" and "B", respectively.
- 4. The Monitor is of the view that the hourly rates charged by Cassels are consistent with the rates charged by large corporate law firms practicing in the area of corporate insolvency and restructuring in the Toronto market, that Cassels' billings reflect work performed consistent with the Monitor's instructions, and that the overall fees charged by Cassels and the Monitor are reasonable and appropriate in the circumstances.

I, **NOAH GOLDSTEIN**, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, **MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. I am a Managing Director of KSV Restructuring Inc. ("KSV"), the Court-appointed monitor (the "Monitor") of Chalice Brands Ltd. (the "Applicant"), and as such I have knowledge of the matters deposed to herein.
- 2. Pursuant to an order of the Ontario Superior Court of Justice ("Court") made on May 23, 2023, the Applicant was granted protection under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* (Canada) (the "CCAA") and KSV was appointed as the Monitor in this proceeding.
- 3. This Affidavit is sworn in support of a motion seeking, among other things, approval of the Monitor's fees and disbursements for the period September 1, 2023 to January 19, 2024 (the "Period").
- 4. The Monitor's invoice for the Period discloses in detail: the nature of the services rendered; the time expended by each person and their hourly rates; the total charges for the services rendered; and the disbursements charged. A copy of the Monitor's invoice is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and the billing summary is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
- 5. The Monitor spent a total of 65.6 hours on this matter during the Period, resulting in fees totalling \$37,596.25, excluding disbursements and HST, as summarized in Exhibit "B".
- 6. As reflected on Exhibit "B", the Monitor's average hourly rate for the Period was \$573.11.

7. I verily believe that the time expended and the fees charged are reasonable in light of the services performed and the prevailing market rates for services of this nature in downtown Toronto.
