ORDER AUTHORIZING SALE FREE AND CLEAR

(Judge David F. Rees)

This matter came before the Court on Receiver's Motion for Authority to Sell Property Free and Clear of Liens and Interests (the "Motion"). Based on the record herein and the Court having considered the record, the Motion, the Declaration of Kenneth S. Eiler in Support of the Motion, the evidence and argument at the hearings on the Motion held on August 28, 2023 and August 31, 2023, and having been fully advised in the premises, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is granted.

2. The Receiver shall have the authority to transfer property of the Purchased Assets.

outside of the ordinary course of business pursuant to ORS 37.110(1)(L) and ORS 37.250.

3. Notice of the Motion was appropriate under the circumstances of this case and was

proper to apprise the owners, secured creditors, and parties claiming an interest in the Purchased

Assets of the Motion and the relief sought therein.

4. Sale of the Purchased Assets on the terms set forth in the Motion and Purchase

Agreement is fair and reasonable, an arms' length transaction, made in good faith, and is in the

best interests of the receivership estate and creditors.

5. The Receiver is authorized to sell and the Purchaser is purchasing and acquiring the

Purchased Assets free and clear of all liens and interests in accordance with the Purchase

Agreement to the Purchaser, APCO, LLC, for the purchase price of \$3,000,000.00, payable in

cash.

6. The Purchaser is purchasing and acquiring the Purchased Assets in good faith as

defined in ORS 37.250(9) and as such is entitled to the protections of a good faith purchaser set

forth in ORS 37.250(5).

7. The Receiver is authorized to execute and deliver such additional documents as

may be reasonably necessary to close the sale contemplated in the Purchase Agreement.

Upon closing of the Sale, the Receiver is authorized to pay (i) all administrative tax 8.

liabilities, whether arising from the Sale or otherwise, (ii) Oregon state taxes required to be paid

as a condition of transfer of the OLCC licenses to Purchaser, and (iii) all allowed administrative

claims against the receivership estate other than to holders of administrative claims who have

agreed to other treatment.

9. Subject to the Court's approval of the settlements between (i) the Receiver and

Homegrown and (ii) the Receiver and High Street, notice of which were filed and served on August

25, 2023, the Receiver is authorized to pay the Settlement Amount described therein upon closing

of the Sale to Purchaser.

- 10. Subject to the Court's approval of the settlement between the Receiver and Bobsled, notice of which will be filed as soon as practicable, the Receiver is authorized to pay the Settlement Amount described therein upon closing of the Sale to Purchaser.
- 11. For the avoidance of doubt, inventory held by Innovative Packaging Company for purchase by Greenpoint Oregon, Inc. under an "inventory agreement" is not property of the receivership estate and is not included in the Purchased Assets and is not being sold to Purchaser pursuant to the Purchase Agreement.
