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**ORDER CLOSING CHAPTER 15 CASES OF CONTRACT
PHARMACEUTICALS LIMITED AND GLASSHOUSE PHARMACEUTICALS LLC**

Upon the *Certification of Counsel and Request for Dismissal* (the “Certification”); and this Court having jurisdiction to consider the Certification and entry of this Order pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Amended Standing Order of Reference* from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, dated February 29, 2012; and it appearing that sufficient notice of the Certification has been given under the circumstances; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Upon entry of this Order, the Chapter 15 case of Contract Pharmaceuticals Limited, Case No. 24-10915 (BLS), and Glasshouse Pharmaceuticals LLC, Case No. 24-10919 (BLS), shall be closed subject to the rights of any interested party to request an order reopening the case in accordance with section 350(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 5010 and the applicable Local Rules.

2. The terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.
