3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** approval of the fees and activities of the Trustee and its counsel, Minden Gross LLP, and the fee accrual as detailed in the Third Report.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that upon the issuing of the Trustee's Certificate contemplated in the Third Report, that KSV shall be discharged as Trustee.
