**ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE KIMMEL:** 

- 1. Mr. Fogul represents the plaintiffs in two civil actions (Yi Jin and Awei Liu in one action and Yuchuan Shao, Sanlin Shao, Jun Xing and Jianzhong Xing in the other action) who seek to lift the stay of proceedings in respect of various companies who are named as defendants in those actions and are in bankruptcy or receivership. Gross Capital Inc. is a common defendant in both actions. There is a stay of proceedings in each of the following bankruptcy/receivership matters that these moving plaintiffs will be asking be lifted:
  - 31-27447949 Bankruptcy of Gross Capital Inc. (this proceeding)
  - 31-2810419 Bankruptcy of Sheldon Gross Limited
  - 31-2842640 Bankruptcy of 100 Colborne Holdings Inc.
  - 31-2842641 Bankruptcy of 240 Old Penetanguish Holdings Inc.
  - 32-2842635 Bankruptcy of 2478658 Ontario Ltd.
  - CV-21-00664273-00CL Receivership of Southmount Healthcare Centre Inc. et al.
  - CV-21-00656098-00CL Receivership of 249 Ontario Street Holdings Inc. et al.
  - CV-21-00665375-00CL Receivership of Victoria Avenue North Holdings Inc. et al.
- 2. The bankruptcy of Gross Capital Inc. was selected by the plaintiffs as the 'representative' estate for the purposes of filing the motion, as it is common between the two civil actions.
- 3. The motions will be the same in all of these eight proceedings. They will be heard concurrently and have been scheduled for one hour on February 8, 2023.
- 4. Counsel shall agree upon a timetable for all pre-hearing steps for the lift stay motion(s) such that all materials shall have been served, filed and uploaded onto CaseLines at least one week prior to the February 8, 2023 hearing date.
