The counsel who appeared on the motion brought in the above-noted matter appear on the counsel slip attached hereto.

RGN Ontario II Limited Partnership ("RGN") brings this motion to extend the time within which it may file a proposal pursuant to s. 50.4(9) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*. It seeks an extension of 45 days from the deadline by which it must file a proposal to and including November 11, 2020.

RGN submits that the extension is required so that it may make a proposal to its creditors. RGN is contemplating a consolidation of this proceeding with the related *CCAA* proceeding to avoid a duplicity of proceedings. The Proposal Trustee supports the granting of the extension

A creditor, CT Tower Investments Inc., objects to the 45-day extension and asks that the extension be limited to two weeks. It submits that two weeks would give RGN sufficient time to respond to the questions it put RGN relating to intercompany accounting issues and the cash management system. The extension could then be considered in light of the responses to its questions. The questions were put to RGN on Monday of this week.

I am not satisfied that RGN could respond satisfactorily to the questions within a two-week period, which could lead to the need for another motion, adding time and expense to the proceedings. Having heard the submissions of RGN and the Proposal Trustee, I am satisfied that RGN is acting in good faith and with due diligence, and will respond to the creditor's questions in a timely manner. Should it fail to do so, CT Tower Investments Inc. has other recourse. RGN submits that it has been working with the Proposal Trustee to stabilize its business operations and, with the extension, it will be in a better position to make a viable proposal to all its creditors. The extension should not be materially prejudicial to any group of creditors, including CT Tower Investments Inc. The First Report of the Proposed Trustee shows that the Partnership is projected to have funding to pay post-filing services and supplies as contemplated by its forecast.
