ORDER (Distributions to UCI)

THIS MOTION, made by KSV Kofman Inc., in its capacity as Court-appointed Monitor (the "Monitor") of the Applicants and the affiliated entities listed on Schedule "A" (collectively, the "CCAA Entities", and each individually a "CCAA Entity"), pursuant to the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. c-36, as amended (the "CCAA") for an order, among other things, approving distributions to Urbancorp Inc. ("UCI") or as Guy Gissin, in his capacity as the appointed functionary and foreign representative of Urbancorp Inc. (the "Israeli Functionary") by order of the District

Court in Tel Aviv-Yafo, Israel (the "Israeli Court"), may otherwise direct, was heard this day at 330 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

ON READING the Notice of Motion of the Monitor and the Twenty-Third Report of the Monitor dated February 22, 2018 (the "**Report**"), and on hearing the submissions of respective counsel for the Monitor, the Israeli Functionary, and such other counsel as were present, no one else appearing although duly served as appears from the Affidavit of Service as filed:

SERVICE

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the time for service of the Notice of Motion and the Motion Record herein is hereby abridged and validated so that this Motion is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof.

DISTRIBUTIONS TO UCI

- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Monitor, for and on behalf of the Cumberland Entities (as defined in the Report), be and is hereby authorized and directed to distribute the amount of \$1,100,000 to UCI or as the Israeli Functionary may otherwise direct in writing.
- 3. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Monitor, for and on behalf of the Cumberland Entities, be and is hereby authorized to make additional distributions from time to time to UCI, or as the Israeli Functionary may otherwise direct in writing, in respect of UCI's admitted claim against the Cumberland Entities, as the Monitor considers appropriate given the availability of residual funds to the Cumberland Entities

from time to time net of reserves and holdbacks which the Monitor determines to be appropriate.

4. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that nothing in this Order shall constitute or be deemed to constitute the Monitor as a receiver, assignee, liquidator, administrator, receiver-manager, agent of any creditor or legal representative of the CCAA Entities within the meaning of any relevant legislation and that any distribution ultimately made to any creditor of the CCAA Entities by the Monitor will be deemed to have been made by the CCAA Entities themselves, and the Monitor shall incur no liability or obligation as a result of the carrying out of the provisions of this Order, other than in respect of its gross negligence or wilful misconduct.

AID AND RECOGNITION

5. THIS COURT HEREBY REQUESTS the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada to give effect to this Order and to assist the Monitor and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to the Monitor, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order or to assist the Monitor and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
