ENDORSEMENT

- [1] The Applicants bring this motion for an order:
 - (a) extending the Stay Period,
 - (b) approving the 50th Report of KSV Restructuring Inc. (the "Monitor"); and
 - (c) approving the fees and disbursements of the Monitor, the Monitor's counsel, and the Applicants' counsel, for the periods referred to in the fee affidavits.
- [2] The motion was not opposed.

- [3] Having reviewed the record, I am satisfied that the Applicants have acted and continue to act in good faith and with due diligence, such that the request to extend the Stay Period to March 31, 2022 is reasonable in the circumstances. In arriving at this conclusion, I have taken into account the Monitor's comment that no creditor will be prejudiced by the extension. I also note that the required Cash Flow Statement has been filed.
- [4] I am also satisfied that it is appropriate to approve the 50th Report of the Monitor. However, in doing so, I note that counsel on behalf of the Foreign Representative takes issue with the concluding sentence in paragraph 3 of Section 3.1, which references that certain financial disclosure remains outstanding. The Foreign Representative disagrees with this statement.
- [5] The fee requests of the Monitor, the Monitor's counsel, and the Applicants' counsel appear to be reasonable in the circumstances and are approved.
- [6] The motion is granted and the order has been signed in the form provided.
